

Which track are you on?

Imagine, if you will, two railroad tracks running parallel to each other. The appearance of the two tracks would seem to be that the tracks lead to the exact same destination. However, what if they actually lead to totally opposite destinations? Let's assume that one track is destined for prosperity and the other is destined for lack. Which one would you be one? You can take it one powerful step further and be a playful actor/actress and "act as if" you are prosperous and feel what prosperity feels like.

The sad part is that the effort isn't necessarily a physical effort but a mental effort -- it is simply a thinking exercise, and believe it or not, people are too lazy to think themselves rich.

Florence Scovel Shinn goes on to say "You must have a desire for financial freedom and you must feel yourself rich, you must see yourself rich, you must continually prepare for riches. You are then impressing the subconscious with expectancy. "

The same premise works with other things as well. Keep 'checking in' to see which track you are on. When you notice your results are not the desired ones, change the track (your direction). If you've been on the track of lack and have decided to switch over to the track of prosperity you may find it difficult at first, but if you keep switching back over to prosperity from the track of lack, it won't be long until you reach a point where you are no longer switching tracks and your results will be a mirrored reflection of your creative energy.

Get on the track of healthy living and stay off the track of toxic poisons.
Get on the track of confidence and get off the track of insecurity.
Get on the track of faith and get off the track of fear.
Get on the track of calm and get off the track of chaos.

Get on the track of gratitude and get off the track of scarcity.
